Pfizer Booster shots are now available for school staff who are 6 months out from the second shot. Maderna booster has not been approved yet. Pediatric vaccines are scheduled to be reviewed by the FDA on October 26. Vaccines for children ages 5-11 could be available sometime in November.

On October 8th CHI held a vaccine clinic. 18 shots were given with 13 shots being done at the school. 11 staff members took advantage of the opportunity. There was 1 first time dose, 2 had their second dose, and 8 were booster shots.
